In the **Information Commons** (just outside the library) you'll find a ChargeTech cell phone and laptop dock charging station with six different retractable cables to accommodate your mobile devices. There are also two USB ports and two universal AC wall outlets. The charging station will work with all Apple, Samsung, and Android devices.

Inside the library we also have a portable ChargeTech station for you to charge your devices or laptop via plug or USB cable. You'll find it on the bright green table towards the back of the library.
