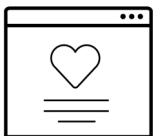

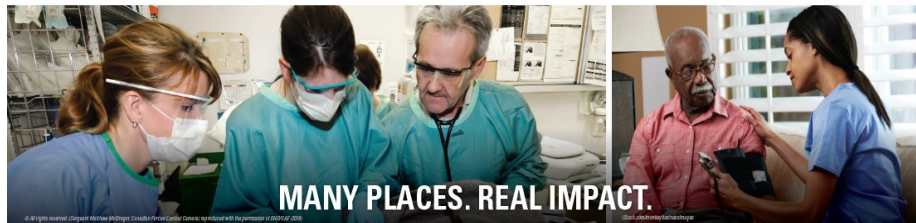
National Nursing Week is May 7-13 and the theme is #YesThisIsNursing! Check out some of the resources for nurses available to you from the Health Sciences Library:
